Montclair Kimberley Academy (MKA) is an independent day school serving about 1,000 students from grades Pre-K–12 in Northern New Jersey. Made up of three campuses — a primary, middle, and upper school — the academy provides an innovative education that combines excellence in teaching, creativity in curriculum, and a highly personal, technology-enriched environment. MKA is recognized as an Apple Distinguished School for 2013–2015 for its unique implementation of Apple technology in its 1:1 laptop learning initiative for grades 4–12, and its use of iPads for grades Pre-K–3.



AN APPLE ON EVERY DESK

Students at MKA use Apple technology to explore learning in new ways, practice skills, and gain valuable lessons in digital citizenship. All faculty and students in grades 4–12 are provided with their own MacBook Air laptop in the school's 1:1 program. Each comes equipped with an identical suite of software to ensure a common platform for instruction. In the

primary school, students have access to over 170 iPads, mobile laptop carts, and a library technology space in the classroom. Students use Apple technology in a range of ways: from creating and publishing their own multimedia projects to practicing math skills via interactive software.

ENABLING CREATIVITY, TEACHING RESPONSIBILITY

The hallmark of MKA's technology initiative is its 1:1 program, which provides every student with a laptop that they are responsible for around the clock, 365 days a year. Students use these laptops in creative ways everyday. Middle school students record their own podcasts in a foreign language, design animations to explain mathematical concepts, and publish research findings online. Upper school students use Macs for everything from analyzing physics concepts using computer-generated simulations, designing websites, to debating current events via an online platform.

To help students gain a sense of ownership and responsibility for their laptops, MKA requires they pass a "Technology Driver's Test" where they manage their Mac just as they would in the real world — from conducting Time Machine backups to installing software updates all on their own.



A SOLUTION FOR NOW — AND THE FUTURE

When MKA began its 1:1 program four years ago, it immediately turned to Jamf Pro to make it all possible. The school was already using Jamf Pro to manage other Apple devices, and liked its best-of-breed technology and same-day support for all new releases. This enables MKA to "future-proof" itself for any new Apple releases. Jamf Pro also features a flexible backend, allowing MKA's IT team to engineer its own out-of-the-box solutions. As a result, MKA is able to design temporary administrative privileges to 30 middle and upper school students who are participating in its Laptop Learning Group. This group of students is trained as the first line of help to solve any technical challenges that may arise in their classrooms. Together with the Laptop Learning Group and Jamf, MKA's sole Apple device administrator is able to manage over 1,400 devices.
