What can it do?



Allow and restrict apps: Choose which apps your child can use on their school-issued devices. Easily restrict the use of game apps and social media on the device so your child can stay focused during their studies.



Enable App Lock: Use App Lock to set a timer for app restrictions. While your child's device is in App Lock, they will only be able to use the apps you allow during a specified time period. This way they can do their homework with no distractions from non-educational apps.



Set locations: See the approximate location of your child's device and set device rules based on the location.



Set device rules: Schedule app restrictions on your child's device. This allows you to schedule homework time or bedtime.



Monitor communication: Keep an eye on your child's communication via popular apps like WhatsApp and Messenger.

Getting Started

There are two ways you can add your child's device to Jamf Parent:



Use the QR code on your child's device



Use the login credentials created in Jamf School.

If this has not been enabled by your school, contact your school IT administrator for a login.

What can a school IT administrator see on my child's device?

Is your child's device owned by the school?

Jamf School stores inventory information for each managed mobile device. You can view the following information for each institutionallyowned mobile device:

- Hardware information*
- Installed apps
- Installed profiles

Is your child's device owned by you?

Jamf School stores a more limited set of inventory details for each personally owned mobile device. You can view the following information for each personally owned mobile device:

- Hardware information*
- Managed apps installed by Jamf School
- Profiles installed by Jamf School

*This includes UDID, serial number, Mac address, model, and capacity operating system information.

Where is Jamf School data stored?

Jamf Cloud uses servers in the United States, Germany, and Japan. Data at rest remains in the region that hosts the Jamf School instance. Jamf processes any personal data it receives through the App in accordance with applicable data privacy laws.
