BEFORE YOU BEGIN

Have your account ready

If you haven't already, [create an account](#) and have it handy for the following tutorial. Make sure you're using Safari, Chrome, or Firefox on a Mac or PC.

Set up Apple Business Manager

Create an [Apple Business Manager](#) account to take advantage of Automated Device Enrollment and Volume Purchasing. It takes about 5 days to set up your account, but you can move on to the next step while you wait.

APNs

The Apple Push Notification service (APNs) is how you create a trusted relationship between your devices, Apple and Jamf. This step is required before you can enroll devices. Make sure you're using the Apple ID used in your Apple Business Manager account.

Automated Device Enrollment

Once your Apple Business Manager account is approved, configure Automated Device Enrollment to enroll and manage devices automatically.

Apps & Volume Purchasing

Volume Purchasing is a free service from Apple that allows you to manage apps in bulk. Volume Purchasing is the best way to save time and start managing apps across your organization today.

Blueprints

Blueprints are the primary way you tell devices how to function while under management with Jamf Now. Blueprints control many aspects of device management, including:

- Distributing apps
- Configuring security settings
- Restricting Safari, iMessage and more

Assign Blueprints

Assign devices to your Blueprints to apply settings to your enrolled devices. If you're using automated device enrollment, you can preassign devices to a Blueprint, so configuration is completed before the device turns on.

Enroll Devices


Open Enrollment is a form of management that is most commonly used for employee- owned hardware.

Supervision is a higher form of management that is primarily used for company-owned devices through Automated Device Enrollment
