Composer Versioning

Composer may have non-consecutive version numbers. The version number always corresponds with a version of Jamf Pro, but Composer is not necessarily released every time Jamf Pro is released.

Note: Jamf Pro (formerly the Casper Suite) is a complete macOS and iOS management solution available from Jamf.

- [PI-005356] Fixed an issue that occasionally prevented Composer from deleting package sources on computers with macOS 10.12.6 or earlier.

Composer can run on the following operating systems:

- macOS 10.7.x (Composer v9.81 or earlier)
- macOS 10.8.x (Composer v9.81 or earlier)
- macOS 10.9.x
- macOS 10.10.x
- macOS 10.11.x
- macOS 10.12.x
- macOS 10.13.x

Composer v9.81 or earlier is available from Jamf Nation.

Upgrading Composer

To upgrade Composer, simply replace it with the most current version.

It is also recommended that you open Composer's Preference window and verify the new Exclusion List.
